

PROJECTED CAPITAL INVESTMENTS

Throughout 2023, we were able to sell properties that amounted to \$3.6 million, indicating a sustained interest in supporting the long-term success of Chaffee Crossing. In the last 26 years, projected capital investments totaling over \$2.6 billion have resulted in the creation of jobs, economic stability, increased sales tax and property tax collections, and higher property values across the region.

JOBS

The current job count reported by Chaffee Crossing businesses has reached 3,518 with future projection reaching nearly 4,500. The sustained job count ensures great opportunity across all industry sectors.

TAXES GENERATED

According to Sebastian County Assessor's office, taxes generated in Chaffee Crossing exceeded \$5.7 million in 2023. Overall estimated taxes since 2011 exceed \$31 million, reflecting strong growth within the community.

A YEAR OF ACHIEVEMENTS FOR ACHE





It was a year of achievements at the Arkansas Colleges of Health Education (ACHE) in 2023. ACHE continued to make strides toward fostering an environment that prioritizes innovation, community inclusivity, and student success.

In 2023, ACHE proudly added 74 modern and comfortable apartments to its campus, providing housing options for its students within, Arkansas College of Osteopathic Medicine, ACHE School of Physical Therapy, ACHE School of Occupational Therapy, Master of Science in Biomedicine, and the newest program, Master of Public Health.

Building C, a cornerstone building in The Village at Heritage cut its ribbon on December 14, 2023. The impressive, 90,000 square foot, three-story structure provides student housing on its second and third floors, with 18,000 square feet of retail space. New businesses that opened in Heritage include Simply Couture Boutique, unWINEd (wine bar), The General Store, The Polka Dotted Zebra, and POSH Aesthetics & Wellness. Opening this spring will be BluPoint Seafood and Steakhouse.

The eight-acre Celebration Garden and Wellness Park has blossomed into a serene park, providing a tranquil escape for students and the community alike. This green haven reflects the ACHE commitment to holistic well-being and serves as a testament to the dedication of creating a harmonious learning environment for the entire community.

ACHE will continue to have tremendous growth in 2024 with the highly anticipated arrival of a grocery store and bank. Future growth includes two new housing structures that will add a total of 16 student apartment units. These additions will further enhance the campus amenities and contribute to the well-being and convenience for its students and a strong economic impact on the community.

PROPERTY SALES

Despite the increase in interest rates and the slowdown in development, real estate sales in Chaffee Crossing are still steady. Experts predict that the sales in 2023 will bring in over \$140 million in capital investments, leading to more job opportunities and residential growth. As there are less than 1,000 acres available, those interested can still become a part of the Chaffee Crossing community.

Securing the FMS foreign fighter pilot training program at the 188th Wing means an opportunity to grow residentially in Chaffee Crossing. There was a swing in new construction of multi-family units in 2023 accounting for 63% of homes being built. Average price of homes in Chaffee Crossing remain the same at \$190,000.
